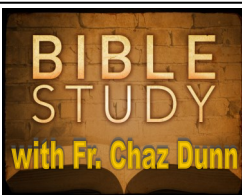

REFLEXIÓN

13 de abril de 2025

ENFOQUE: Porque Cristo se humilló, Dios lo exaltó grandemente.

El Evangelio de Lucas hace hincapié en la necesidad de que los discípulos de Cristo sigan sus pasos, ya que Jesús dice a los Apóstoles que está entre ellos *como el que sirve*. Como el siervo del Señor del que se habla en la lectura del profeta Isaías, Cristo no rechaza su llamada. Se somete voluntariamente al sufrimiento por nuestro bien. Siguiendo el ejemplo de Cristo, es a través del servicio humilde a los demás como seremos exaltados.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

Jesús se dirige a Jerusalén, donde es recibido como un rey, con gritos de júbilo que alaban a Dios por sus poderosas hazañas. En la primera lectura, Isaías profetiza acerca de aquel que no esconde su rostro de los abucheos ni de los escupitajos, sabiendo que no será avergonzado. Pablo escribe que Cristo se humilló a sí mismo, haciéndose obediente hasta la muerte de cruz. En el Evangelio, Jesús celebra la Pascua con sus amigos, habla de su inminente traición y, tras horas de interrogatorio y tortura, es entregado para ser crucificado.

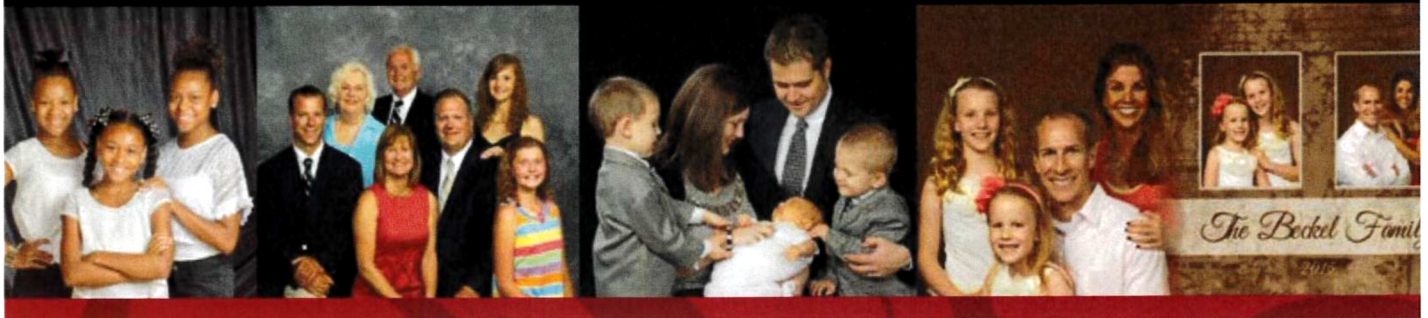



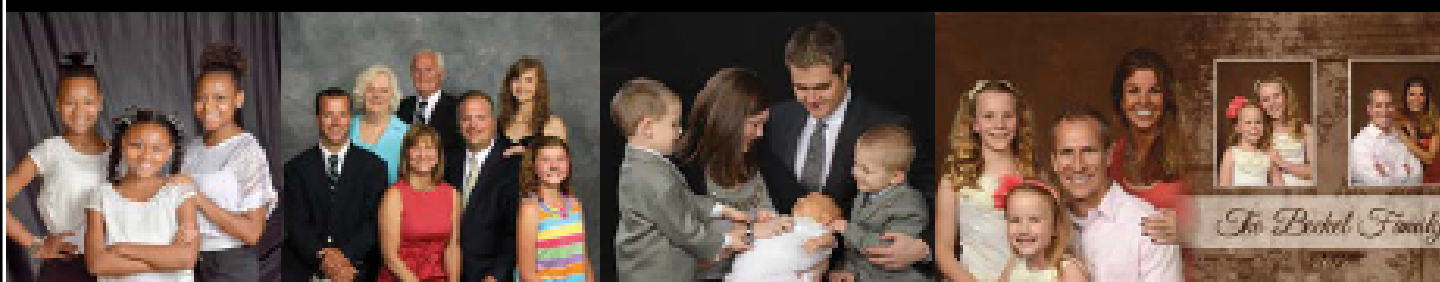

REFLECTION

April 13, 2025

FOCUS: Because Christ humbled himself, God greatly exalted him.

Luke's Gospel emphasizes the need for disciples of Christ to follow in his footsteps, as Jesus tells the Apostles that he is among them *as the one who serves*. Like the servant of the Lord who is spoken of in the reading from the prophet Isaiah, Christ does not refuse his calling. He willingly submits to suffering for our sake. Following Christ's example, it is through humble service to one another that we will be exalted.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Jesus proceeds to Jerusalem, where he is welcomed as a king with shouts of joy praising God for his mighty deeds. In the first reading, Isaiah prophesies of one who does not shield his face from buffets or spitting, knowing he will not be put to shame. Paul writes that Christ humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death on a cross. In the Gospel, Jesus celebrates Passover with his friends, speaks of his imminent betrayal, and after hours of interrogation and torture, is handed over to be crucified.

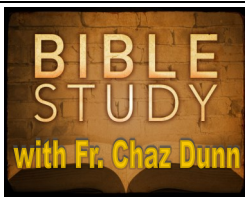
