REFLEXIÓN

22 de Febrero 2026

ENFOQUE: Jesús es el Hijo obediente.

A lo largo del Antiguo Testamento, las Escrituras emplean un lenguaje metafórico para hablar de Israel como hijo de Dios. Sin embargo, al igual que nosotros hoy, los israelitas persisten en la desobediencia y se apartan de la voluntad de su Padre. Dios envía así a Jesús, que es tentado en el desierto para que desobedezca a Dios. El ejemplo de la obediencia de Jesús revela lo que exige la verdadera filiación.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura de hoy del Génesis, Dios crea al hombre y lo coloca en un jardín. Adán y Eva desobedecen a Dios al comer del árbol del conocimiento. En la segunda lectura, Pablo compara la desobediencia de Adán con la obediencia de Jesús, la transgresión con el don. El Evangelio relata la estancia de Jesús en el desierto, donde es tentado por el diablo.

Fasting and Abstinence reminders:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

REFLECTION

February 22, 2026

FOCUS: Jesus is the obedient Son.

Throughout the Old Testament, the Scriptures use metaphorical language to speak of Israel as God's son. Yet like us today, the Israelites persist in disobedience, straying from their Father's will. God thus sends Jesus, who is tempted in the desert to disobey God. Jesus' example of obedience reveals what true sonship requires.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In today's first reading from Genesis, God creates man and places him in a garden. Adam and Eve disobey God by eating from the tree of knowledge. In the second reading, Paul compares the disobedience of Adam to Jesus' obedience, transgression to gift. The Gospel recounts Jesus' time in the desert, where he is tempted by the devil.
